<u>Stage Lighting Design: The Art, The Craft, The Life - Richard Pilbrow</u> / Very much considered to be the bible of theatre lighting design but is a bit dated and wordy, and doesn't have many visual examples. That said, the first few chapters dealing with building a basic lighting design are brilliant and overall it's an excellent reference guide.

<u>Light for Visual Artists - Richard Yot / Although not specific to theatre design, this fantastic book is a complete and easily accessible resource for understanding how light works.</u> Recommended.
